

Update of September 24, 2010

The new well field that was approved by DEQ for helping to reduce or eliminate the methane gas related odors that may be coming from Cell VI at the regional landfill has been installed. All wells, well heads and connecting pipe have been hooked up and are actively pulling gas from the landfill. The gas is being taken from the landfill to the "flare" where it is burned in accordance with federal and state guidelines.

No "putrescible" waste (waste from municipal and business type garbage which decays and forms gas) is being dumped into the landfill. The only material being received and disposed of at this time is construction and demolition type debris and similar clean up material.

Daily cover material which is dirt continues to be used to cover the materials.

Regular monitoring of the gas wells and the site are being done.

SPSA has received less than a half dozen odor complaints over the last several months. The phone number to report odor complaints which may be coming from the landfill is 417-5251.
